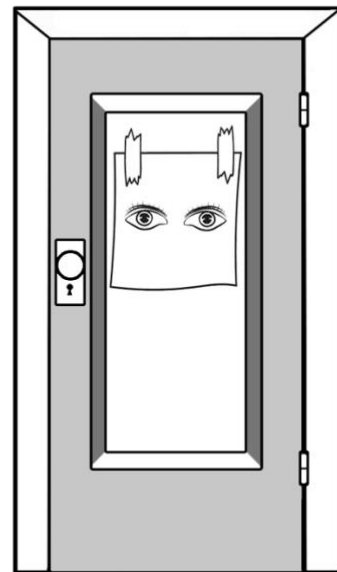
God wants to get our attention.

Through the Week

- Draw sets of eyes to remind you to look for God. (Or cut eyes out of magazines.)
- Place the pairs of eyes in places you'll see them often. Hang them on the fridge or front door, stick them to the car dashboard, or place them in backpacks and briefcases.
- Whenever you see the eyes, refocus on your surroundings. Remember that God is there with you. Say a quick prayer that God will help you pay attention to him.
- At the end of each day, talk with your family about what you noticed about God that day.
